This line, representing 18 miles per gallon in 1978, is 0.6 inches long.



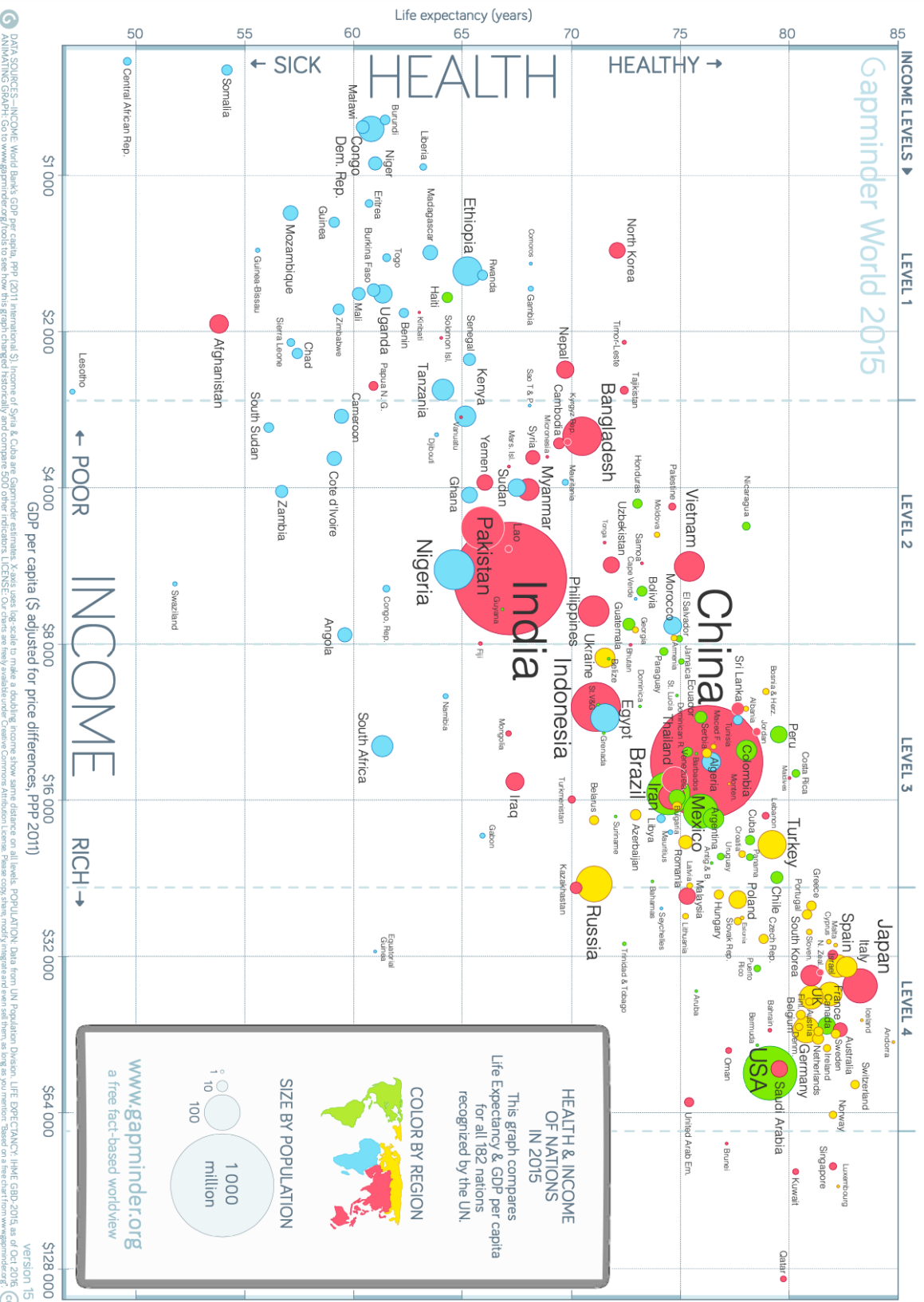

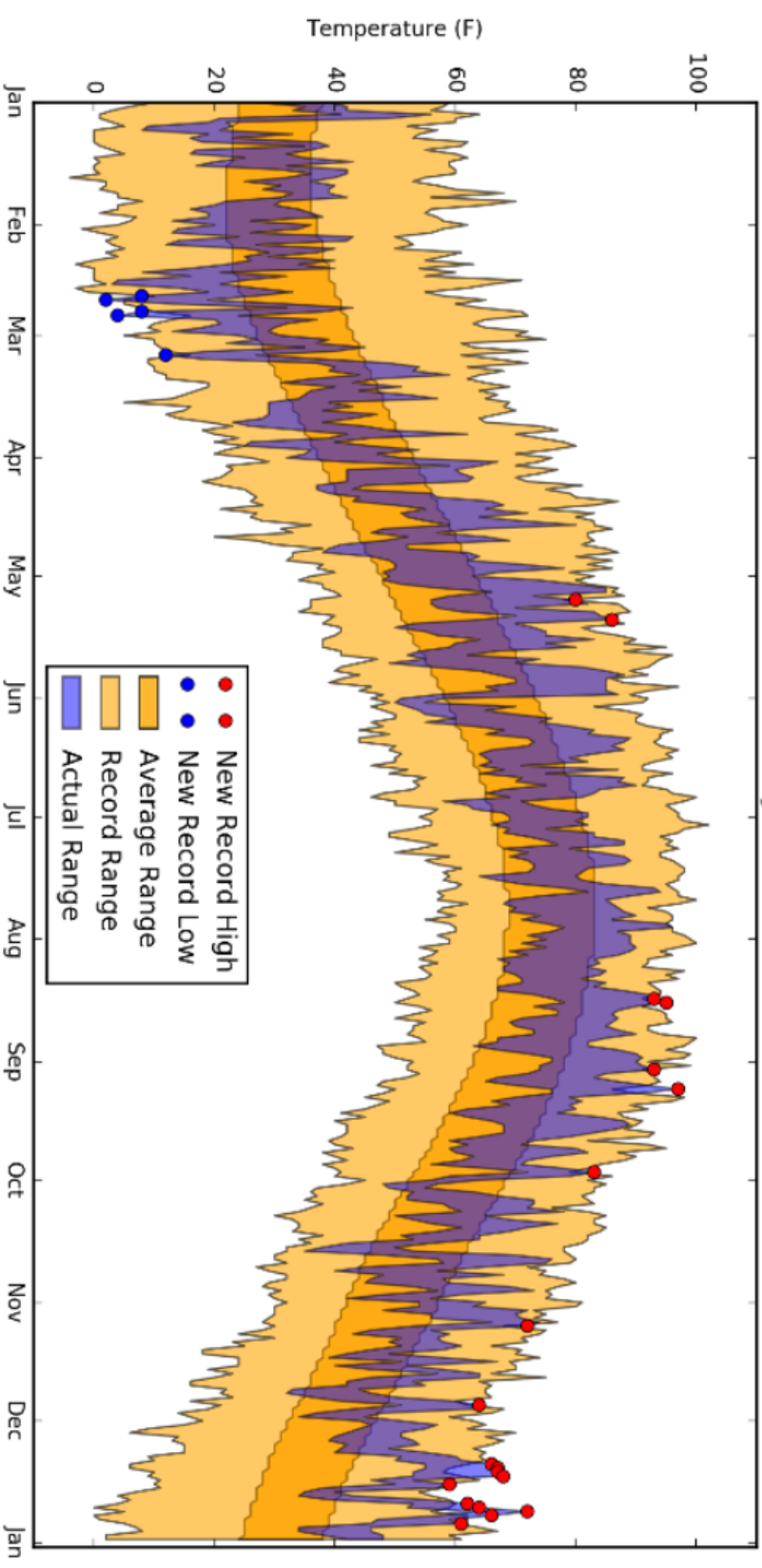

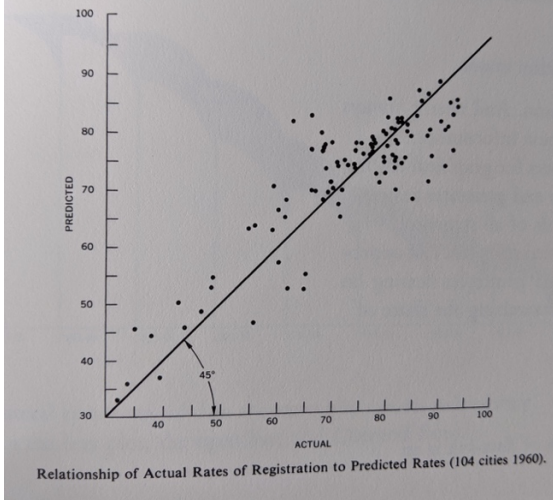
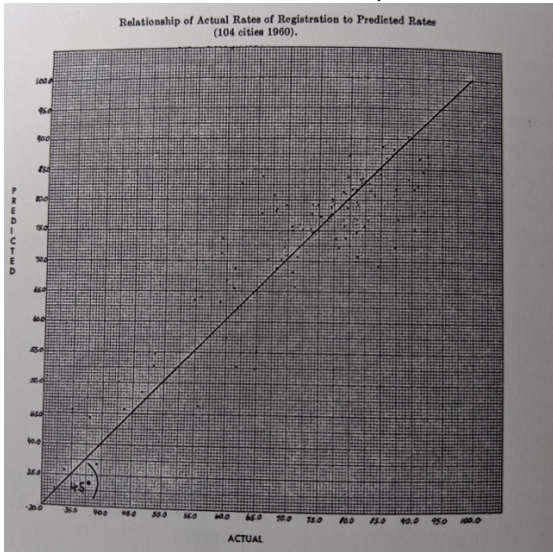
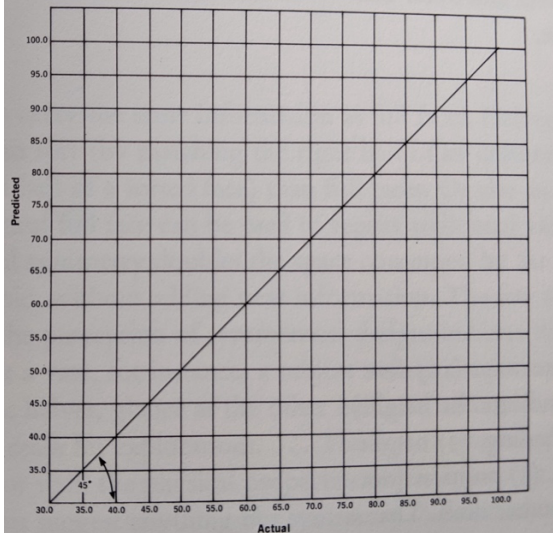
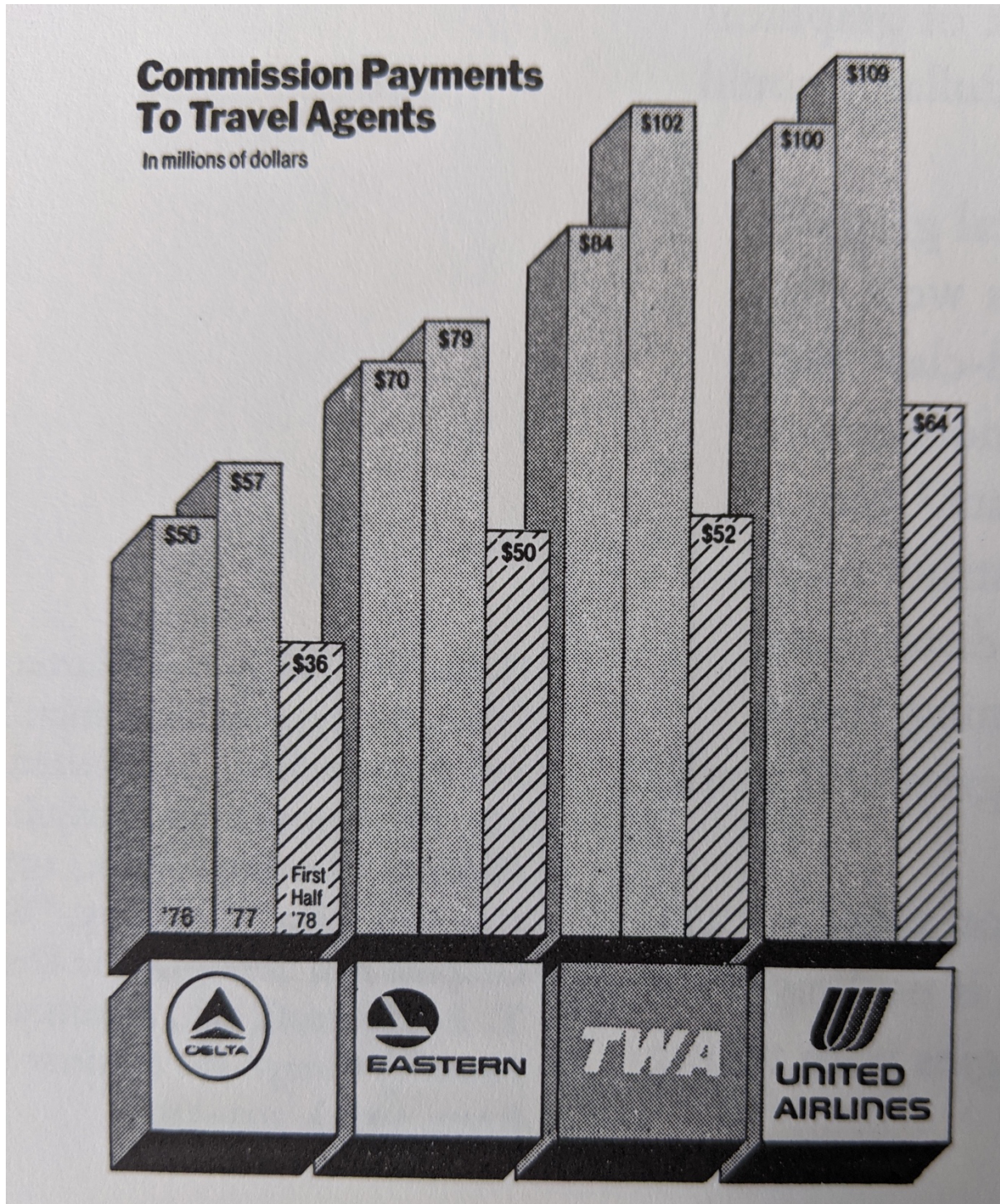


Figure 19.1 Relationship of Actual Rates of Registration to Predicted Rates (104 cities, 1960)
